


How to set up a GPS to view and use POI's (Bear Creek Survey Svc. LLC 12/2014)


First - Prepare the GPS. The illustrations are from a Garmin Etrex 30.

POI's work like Waypoints if your GPS is configured correctly. The most important setting is the **Map Zoom** levels. This is done by following these steps:


1. Select *Setup*




2. Select > *Map*




3. Select > **Text Size, Zoom, etc.**



4. Turn Auto Zoom **Off**



5. Select *Zoom Levels - Points, Streets, etc..*



6. Set **Map Points** and User **Waypoints** to **200 miles**



This will assure that when you perform a *Where To* action, all the waypoints on the page will be displayed. The setup is now complete.

Navigating to a POI:


The different data types are accessible via the "**Where To**" Icon, which looks like magnifying glass. This is used to navigate to a feature. This is on the top level menu.




POI's are viewed in "**Extras**". They will **NOT** be accessed under the "**All POIs**" or "**Waypoints**" menus. (The correct Garmin icon looks like a **wrapped present** on most recently marketed units) If you do not see the wrapped package icon, then the POI's are not properly installed on the unit.





If you press on the icon, the databases are displayed. **COWP_2015** contains all the waypoints for Colorado.



Select a **Waypoint**. They are arranged by proximity to the GPS location.




Selecting a Waypoint from the list will bring you to the **map view**.



You can zoom in or out using the zoom keys on the GPS.

Selecting the point will reveal the details of the Waypoint



To navigate to the point Select **Go**
